Calculator: You should have a graphing calculator. The TI-85 is suggested, but not required.

Quizzes: There will be a quiz each Monday. Since you have Monday Sept 2 off, there will be a quiz on Wednesday Sept 4. Quizzes will cover homework problems, examples given in class and problems from previous final exams. Quizzes may include problems from earlier material. On some quizzes you will not be allowed to use a calculator, on some you will. Your lowest quiz grade will be dropped.

Final Exam: There will be a two hour final exam. All calculus 150 sections take the same final. You may use a calculator on the final.

Grades: The final will be weighted to count as one fifth of your final grade. After averaging your quizzes and final exam, 90% will be the cut off for an A, 80% for a B, etc.

Cheating: The minimum penalty for cheating is a grade of F in the course. Your Dean may wish to take further action. This is a big no no. There may be multiple versions of the quizzes.
