Calculator: You should have a graphing calculator. The TI-85 is suggested, but not required.

Quizzes: There will be a quiz every other Wednesday. Quizzes will cover homework problems, examples given in class and problems from previous final exams. Quizzes may include problems from earlier material. On some quizzes you will not be allowed to use a calculator, on some you will.

Homework: Homework sets will be collected every other Tuesday. There are also homework problems that will not be collected but may appear on the quizzes.

Final Exam: There will be a two hour final exam. All calculus 150 sections take the same final. You may use a calculator on part of the final.

Grades: The homework average, the quiz average and the final exam grade will each count as $1/3$ of your final grade. After averaging 90% will be the cut off for an A, 80% for a B, etc.

Cheating: The minimum penalty for cheating is a grade of F in the course. Your Dean may wish to take further action. This is a big no no. There may be multiple versions of the quizzes. You can work together on the homework, but the work you turn in should be your own.
